Update on Election

On August 25, 2018 we mailed out 5,837 postcards to property owner's notifying property owners to the changes in the ballot process. As of today only three postcards have been returned to us with no forwarding address. Last year we had over a thousand ballots that were returned to us marked "undeliverable". This year we worked very hard in updating the list and verifying good addresses of all property owners. We are confident with the address list and feel that this will overall reduce the undeliverable ballots as well as prevent interference of unauthorized alterations.

We have seven candidates that submitted packets and all seven have been vetted and approved. John Lagravier, Ken Kunz, Mike Sizemore, Joe Bledsoe, Steve Brodine, Don Madewell & William Hartmann.

- 6. Friday, November 2, 5 pm, all mail-in-ballots must be received by 5 pm.
